What makes a good Fell Foxhound

The judges today will be looking for a hound with good confirmation (well put together). It should have a good shoulder and long neck, level back, good ribs with a deep chest depicting good lungs. It should have good feet – not hare feet, or cow hocks and a curly stern is not a good feature either. The hind legs need to show agility and spring so they can jump the fell walls. Dog hounds must have a masculine head, while bitches should have a smaller lighter head, neither to have dished face. They also need a correct mouth and not to be undershot.
